

DISPUTES:

You may request to vacate a default judgment by contacting OATH at: <https://www.nyc.gov/site/oath/hearings/reopen-a-missed-hearing-default-online.page> OATH will then decide whether to grant or deny the motion to vacate the default judgment.

If you feel you are a victim of identity theft pursuant to N.Y.
