A2	Alteration Type 2	Multiple types of work that do not change the use, egress or occupancy of the building.	Home renovations that include a new kitchen, new plumbing and gas work and general construction.
A3	Alteration Type 3	Minor alteration involving one type of work and that does not change use, egress or occupancy of the building.	General construction that may include repair work involving a home's windows or walls.
