SON KILLS MOTHER AND SELF.

James Conwell Turns on Gas in Their Apartment in Manhattan.

John Conwell, 42 years old, a brakeman on the Long Island Railroad, opened all the gas cocks of the fixtures in the three-room apartment occupied by himself and his aged mother at 336 East Fifty-sixth street, Manhattan, some time after 1 o'clock this morning and when the escaping gas alarmed the other tenants, an da policeman forced in the door of the apartment at 7:30 a.m.

Conwell was found dead in bed and the mother unconscious on a lounge in the kitchen. She died soon afterward.
