<b>PAPER</b>  We now accept <b>ALL Glossy Paper &amp; Color Paper!</b>	 <p>Office &amp; School Paper Newspapers &amp; Inserts Envelopes (even with Glassine window) Manila Envelopes, Junk Mail Catalogs &amp; Magazines • Construction Paper Hardcover, Paperback &amp; Telephone Books</p>	 <p>Metallic Paper Used Paper Plates &amp; Cups</p>	<p><b>Regular Recycle Day</b></p> <p>Stack your recyclable paper in bundles, or paper bags and secure with twine.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place bundles on top of your recycling bucket.</li> <li>• Do not separate paper types.</li> </ul>
<b>CARDBOARD</b>  We now accept <b>Cardboard!</b>	<p><b>Cardboard – Any Color, Any Kind</b></p> <p>Storage Boxes Cereal, Food &amp; Pizza Boxes Drink Containers</p>	<p><b>No restrictions</b></p>	<p><b>Wednesdays**</b></p> <p>Please bundle if possible. Just set your cardboard boxes curbside by 8am and they will be picked up. **Scheduled pickup changed as of Dec. 2012</p>
<b>PLASTICS</b>  We now accept <b>All Plastics 1 thru 7*</b>	<p>ALL plastic containers with Number 1 thru 7* in the center of the triangle on the container.</p> <p>Example: </p>	<p>Plastic Bags &amp; Wraps 6 - Pack Holders &amp; Rings (please cut)</p>	<p><b>Regular Recycle Day</b></p> <p>Rinse residue and leave loose inside your recycle bucket.</p> <p>*There are only 7 code numbers, so, if you see a triangle, it's recyclable!</p>
<b>SMALL METALS</b> 	<p>Food &amp; Beverage Cans Aluminum Foil</p>	<p>Empty Aerosol Cans</p>	<p><b>Regular Recycle Day</b></p> <p>Rinse residue and leave loose inside your recycle bucket.</p>
<b>LARGE METALS</b>	<p>Refrigerators (remove doors), Dishwashers, Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Air Conditioners, Bicycles</p>		<p><b>Wednesdays</b></p> <p>Call DPW (676-4402) at least one day prior to schedule curbside pickup.</p>
<b>GLASS</b> 	<p>All Clear, Opaque, or Colored Glass Containers</p>	<p>Light Bulbs • Window &amp; Auto Glass Mirrors &amp; Drinking Glass Pottery, Dishes, Clay Pots</p>	<p><b>Regular Recycle Day</b></p> <p>Rinse residue and leave loose inside your recycle bucket.</p>
<b>ELECTRONICS</b> 	<p>Computers, Printers, Fax machines, Cell Phones, CD and DVD players, Stereos, Televisions Video Game Consoles, Hand-held Electronics</p>	<p>Microwaves and Small Household Appliances</p>	<p><b>Bring to the City's special E-Waste events held in spring and fall.</b></p> <p>Check City website or watch for City notices for event dates, location and details.</p>
<b>POLLUTANTS</b> 	<p>Most Pesticides and Insecticides • Drain and Oven Cleaners Waste Motor Oil &amp; Anti-freeze • Brake &amp; Transmission Fluids Enamel, Lead -based and Oil-based paints Wood Preservatives • Automobile Tires &amp; Batteries Consumer Batteries • Empty BBQ type Propane Tanks Pool Chemicals • Air Conditioning Refrigerants</p>	<p>Water &amp; Latex Paint Cans - dried out</p>	<p><b>Bring to the City's annual S.T.O.P. event (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) held in the fall.</b></p> <p>Check City website or watch for City notices for event dates, location and details.</p>
