Received word yesterday that we're going home. I don't know exactly when but it should be within a few months - as soon as I hear something definite I'll let you know.

I sure had a hard time getting married. Didn't have a penny and am still broke. Vicki's allotment (mom will still get her.) won't be coming through for some time yet and she's given up her job temporarily. Looks like she'll have to go back to work soon we can't live all the time on love and with all my allotments and things I have taken out of my pay I got very little. What happened to that \$100. I sent you last year (joke) - In case you're interested I have 73 points as of May 12. and 81 as of VT day. You figure it out when I'll be discharged. Love and kisses
