VII. That the defendant should have the care, custody and control of the children of plaintiff and defendant, Ronald Lee Simon, age nine; and Kenneth Robert Simon, age six and one-half; and that plaintiff should have the right of visitation at any and all reasonable times.

It Is Therefore Considered, Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed, That said plaintiff be divorced from said defendant, and that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between said parties be dissolved, set aside and held for naught, and said parties released from all obligations thereunder. And it is further ordered and adjudged that this decree of divorce shall not become absolute and take effect until the expiration of six months from date,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant be and he is hereby awarded the care, custody and control of said children; and that plaintiff be and she is hereby awarded the right of visitation at any and all reasonable times.
