Dear Customer:

Early in 2017, the only plant in the United States which produced 20/1 Polyester shut down production of that product for lack of volume. It was anticipated that the production would resume as it had in the past.

It now appears that the production of 20/1 polyester will not resume and that there is no other source in the United States of 20/1 polyester.

Since the shutdown, we have been working off inventory to fill orders for fabrics that require U.S. made 20/1 for Berry Amendment compatible products. That inventory is depleted and will shortly run out.

If you are in receipt of this letter, we have reason to believe you require U.S. made 20/1 polyester in your product. If you continue to require product that contains U.S. made 20/1 polyester, please contact me regarding the possibilities moving forward. The possibilities might include non-U.S. made 20/1 polyester or a new fabrication which does not contain 20/1 polyester.
