PHYSICAL EXAM

B/P: 118/72 mmHg HR: 52 bpm R: /min Weight: 180 lbs.

GENERAL - WNWD. No acute distress.

NECK - Supple. No JVD. Thyroid is normal in size.

RESPIRATORY - Effort is unlabored. Lungs are clear.

CARDIOVASCULAR - PMI is non-displaced. Rhythm is regular. S1 and S2 are normal. No S3, S4 murmur or rubs. Carotid upstrokes and amplitudes are normal. Abdominal aorta is midline and is not enlarged. Pedal pulses are full volume. No peripheral arterial bruits. No significant LE edema.

NEURO - AAOX3. Pleasant.

SKIN - Well healed sternal and saphenectomy incisions.

EKG - NSR, LAE and otherwise normal.

IMPRESSION: 1. Remains stable.
